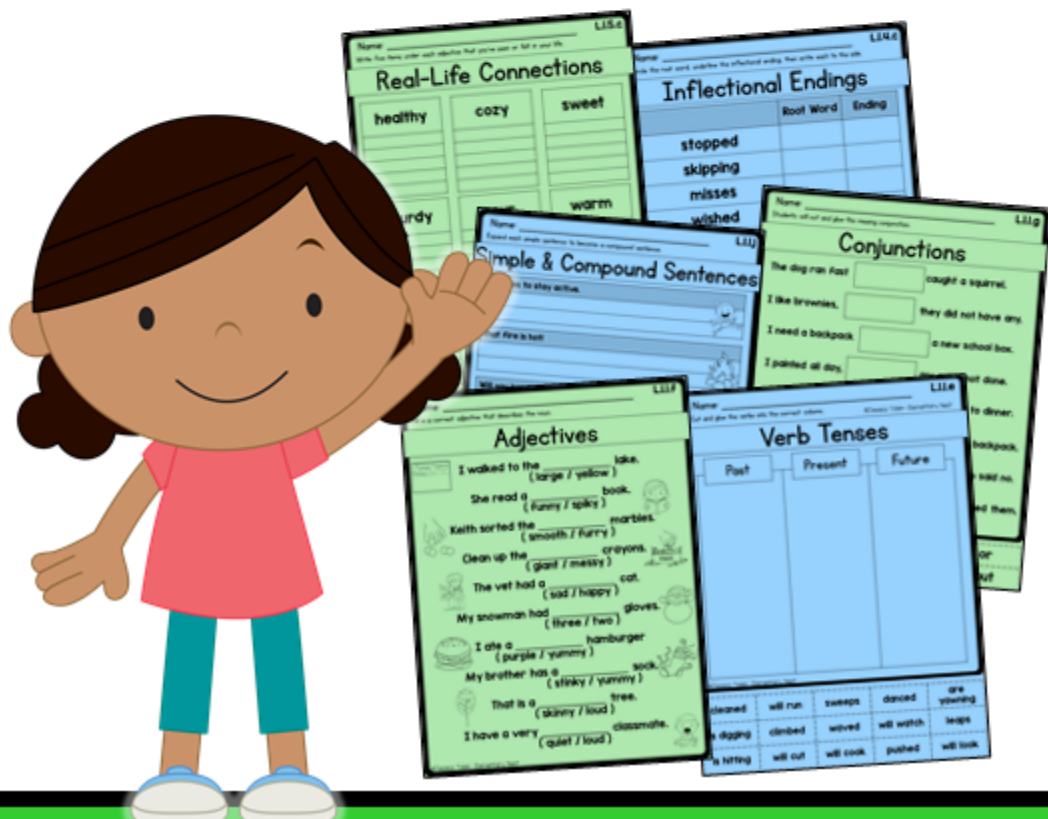


What's in this collection?
